

Joanna Gollberg - "Embellishing Jewelry with Handmade Prong Settings

"Please bring your basic hand tools. These include:

Sawframe
Sawblades 3/0
Lubricant for sawblades
Bench Pin
Files
Needle Files
Assorted Sandpaper (wet/dry)
Ring Clamp (wood preferred)
Pliers (Round/Flat/etc.)
Wire cutters
Scribe
6" ruler
Tweezers
Flex shaft tools, there are 2 flex shafts in the studio. Bring your own if you like.
Optvisor/Magnifying glasses (if needed)

Recommended to bring:

Bench Pin with "C" Clamp if you have a favorite.
Wire solder, Hard and Easy, ~5ft each
Chip Solder, Easy, ½ oz
Wooden handled cross-locking tweezers
Solder pick

Suggestions for materials:

Do not go get all of this if you don't have it! Bring what you have!

Sterling Silver:

Half round wire of a variety of thicknesses
Flat wire in a few sizes. I like 8 x 2mm, 5 x 2mm, and 3 x 2mm
20g, 22g, or 24g sheet (1 x 2", but it depends on what you want to make!!)
Round wire in a variety of sizes and lengths (20g, 18g, 16g, 12g)
Beads, found objects, and stones
Any decorated sheet, doo-das, or wire you already have
Easy and hard 22g wire solder, 5 feet each

Any other metal sheet or wire you want to use—brass, copper, nickel, bronze.

Please do not fret about exact amounts or not having everything! It always, always works out.
Bring what you have on hand if you are not sure what to get.
